Federal State Planning and Regional Planning Brandenburg (1990-1992)

- Designation of Central Places at the beginning of the 1990ties
e.g. size, services and commuting area of potential basic and medium-sized centre, development of the aims in the Federal State of Brandenburg, comparison with so-called Siedlungszentren in the GDR,
- Reorganisation of districts in the Federal State of Brandenburg (1992),
variants of possible combinations of districts to larger units according to criteria like homogeneity and heterogeneity, evaluated by means of Formal Concept Analysis,
- Types of community,
development of a typification of communities for the Federal State of Brandenburg based on inventory and of the district planning authorities as well as types of community in other regions (1992, on behalf of the Brandenburg Ministry for Environment, Nature Conservation and Spatial Planning),
- Locations of Air Traffic in the Federal State of Brandenburg,
Spatial analysis of the economic importance of the existing locations of air traffic in the State of Brandenburg (1992, on behalf of the WIB Weltrauminstitut Berlin)
